



The International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers

- Adopted on 7 July 1978 and entered into force on 28 April 1984
- 167 States are Party to the STCW 1978 Convention (as of 13 April 2023)
- Supplemented by the Seafarers' Training, Certification and Watchkeeping (STCW) Code
 - part A, mandatory provisions
 - part B, recommended guidance

Key provisions of the STCW Convention

- Communication of information (Regulation I/7)
 (MSC.1/Circ.1163/Rev.13 refers)
- Quality standards (Regulation I/8)
 (MSC.1/Circ.1164/Rev.26 refers)
- "Control" measures
- validity and authenticity <u>check</u> of certificates

Chapter IV - Radiocommunication and radio operators

- Applies to radio operators on ships operating in the GMDSS.
- "Every person in charge of or performing radio duties on a ship required to participate in the GMDSS shall hold an appropriate certificate related to the GMDSS, issued or recognized by the Administration under the provisions of the Radio Regulations".
- Radio operators on non-GMDSS ships are required to comply with the Radio Regulations.
- Provisions of Chapter IV are supported by STCW Code Part A and Part B.
